## A balancing act: Exploring how medical educators role model vulnerability whilst maintaining credibility

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## **Synopsis**

Most of us spend time perfecting our workshops and presentations so that they look flawless. We don't like to make mistakes or show vulnerability. Yet we expect our registrars to open up to us, discuss their mistakes and take on feedback.
